## Key responsibilities

- Quality Check of production in-progress (from file to finished garment)
- Preferably assisting with procurement and supplier-contact
- Preferably assisting with pattern and techpack QC and preparations
- Keep process documentation up to speed
- ad hoc day-to-day tasks

## Professional competences

- Applicants should study fashion design and production technology, supply chain management or the like.
- Should know the basics of pattern making and understand shape development 2D to 3D, and be skilled in Adobe Illustrator

And / Or:

- Should know the basics of procurement, supply chain management and logistics, and accustomed to work in Excel or other spreadsheet-programs.
- Be helpful by nature and a natural team-player.
- Ability to work independently (but never too proud to ask questions).

- Excellent eye for detail.
- Understand the entire fashion value chain with a particular interest in clothing production
- Have a desire to reduce the footprint of the fashion industry.
- Sewing skills a plus, but not required.
